### **National Park Service, U.S. Park Police Temporary Closed East Potomac Park/Hains Point on Sunday, June 28, 2009**

Washington D.C. – The National Park Service (NPS) and the U.S. Park Police (USPP) temporary closed East Potomac Park/Hains Point to all pedestrian and vehicular traffic on Sunday, **June 28**. The road will be closed from the golf course entrance on Ohio Drive to Buckeye Drive on the river-side of the point until **Thursday, July 2, 2009**.

This road closure is being done in an effort to accommodate NPS' logistics and setup for the upcoming NPS, Independence Day Celebration, on July 4. Every effort is being made to minimize traffic delays and accomplish the work in a timely manner. Affected park and roads will re-open only when all logistics and setup is complete.

Inclement weather delays may require adjustments to the schedule. The NPS will continue to inform the public and the media of any adjustments in the work schedule. The NPS regrets any inconvenience and appreciates the public's understanding.
